2020 – 2021 PARENT AGREEMENT & REGISTRATION CONSENT FORM

- ❖ As parents, we recognize that we are our child(ren)'s Primary Catechist, that is, their first educators in the Faith. Therefore, we commit to:
 - ◆ Creating a prayerful atmosphere in our homes
 - ◆ Making the Religious Education of our child our **TOP PRIORITY**
 - ◆ Ensuring that my child arrives to class on time and avoid any unnecessary absences
 - ◆ Having my child bring all required materials to class, as requested by the catechist
 - ◆ Assisting my child in their religious education, including, but not limited to, helping them learn their prayers, making-up missed lessons and creating a habit of regularly practicing our faith
 - ◆ Regularly attending the Holy Mass with my child/family every Sunday and Holy Day of Obligation
 - ◆ Using my time, talent, and treasure in support of our parish, registering as members of the parish, and using our offertory envelopes as a sign of my active participation within the parish community
 - ◆ Attending all required meetings and/or parent retreats as part of my child's Sacramental preparation
 - ◆ Ensuring my child attends his/her required Sacramental Retreat
 - ◆ Submitting all fees and required documentation in a timely manner, including those of my child's Confirmation Sponsor

- ❖ I understand that my Baptismal promise to raise my child in the Catholic Faith exceeds simply Sacramental Preparation and am aware that the Saint Patrick Faith Formation Program offers ongoing grade level classes in non-Sacramental years.

- ❖ I understand that attendance at grade level classes are not required, only mastery of content. I recognize that the text books have supplemental parent lessons I will use to teach the Faith to my child when they do not attend classes. As proof that the lesson has been taught, I agree to have my child take the online assessment and forward the results. In addition, I understand that my child will be quizzed upon their return to classes to demonstrate mastery of content. Excess absences and/or lack of knowledge may require that a grade level be repeated, and reception of a Sacrament be delayed.

- ❖ I understand that the Sacramental Preparation program requires a minimum of two (2) consecutive years of catechesis before any Sacrament may be conferred. In addition, I recognize that the Sacramental Preparation programs are administered via workshops separate from grade level classes. And that these workshops require attendance and may not be missed.

I FULLY UNDERSTAND AND AGREE TO ALL OF THE ABOVE AND CONSENT TO THE ENROLLMENT OF MY CHILD(REN) IN THE SAINT PATRICK FAITH FORMATION PROGRAM.
